KEY FACTS AND OFFICER ADVICE:

Council Procedure Rule 34 (1) requires the Council to establish regulatory Committees and any other Committees it feels necessary in order to discharge the function of the Authority.

The structure proposed for the Municipal Year 2004/2005 is a proposal in line with the Executive/Overview and Scrutiny split and is set out in more detail in the Constitution of the Council.
