<p>WHAT ARE THE KEY POINTS?</p> <p>Council Procedure Rule 35 (1) requires the Council to establish Regulatory Committees and any other Committees it feels necessary in order to discharge the functions of the Authority.</p> <p>The structure proposed for the Municipal Year 2008/2009 is a proposal in line with the Executive/Overview and Scrutiny split and is set out in more detail in the Constitution of the Council.</p> <p>This means that, with the exception of Scrutiny Panels, the Planning Sub-Committees and the Regulatory and Licensing Panels, all other Committees and the Appeals Panel and Corporate Parenting Panel are essentially stand alone and require to be approved by the Council under the Procedure Rule. These are:-</p> <p>Overview and Scrutiny Management Committee Standards Committee Planning and Highways Committee Personnel Committee Corporate Governance and Audit Committee</p> <p>Area Committees for Batley, Birstall and Birkenshaw, Colne Valley, Denby Dale, Dewsbury, Holme Valley North, Holme Valley South, Huddersfield North, Huddersfield South, Kirkburton, Mirfield and Spen Valley</p> <p>Licensing and Safety Committee Appeals Panel Corporate Parenting Panel</p>
