**Item 5 – Announcements by the Mayor and Chief Executive**

The Mayor advised of the death of former Colne Valley Councillor Dorothy Lindley, who had previously served as a Councillor for 20 years. Tributes were paid by Councillors Light, Bellamy, Sheard, Ridgway and Sims.

The Chief Executive advised of the official return of the election of Councillors held on 22 May 2014, as per the detailed report, and that all Members had made the statutory declaration of acceptance of office. The Chief Executive also welcomed the three newly elected Councillors; Councillor Bill Armer, Councillor Karen Allison and Councillor Erin Hill.

The Chief Executive also advised of the resignation of Councillor Kath Pinnock as Leader of the Liberal Democrat Group, and the subsequent appointment of Councillor Nicola Turner as Group Leader, and Councillor Andrew Marchington as Deputy Group Leader.

The Chief Executive invited the Leader of the Council to appoint the Members of Cabinet for the 2014/2015 Municipal Year;
