## Kirklees Schools Forum Representation 2013-14

Extracts from The Schools Forums (England) Regulations 2012 (see DfE website)
4-(6) Primary schools, secondary schools and Academies must be broadly proportionately represented on the forum, having regard to the total number of pupils registered at them.

## Schools members

5.-(1) Schools members must be elected to the schools forum by the members of the relevant group, or sub-group, in the authority's area. (2) The groups are- (b) representatives of primary schools other than nursery schools; (c) representatives of secondary schools;

## Academies members

6.-(1) Academies members must be elected to the schools forum by the proprietors of the Academies in the authority's area.

## Summary

1. Primary schools, secondary schools and academies must be represented in proportion to numbers of pupils at the schools
2. Primary and secondary maintained school reps must be elected by the maintained school members of their heads groups
3. Academies reps must be elected by the academy trusts/governors
