Impact of changes to the location of Early Help sites on Kirklees residents

It is recognised that changes to the location of Early Help sites may have a negative impact on certain protected groups of Kirklees residents due to difficulties they may experience in travelling greater distances. We anticipate this will be most significant in rural areas where travelling distances are greater and public transport options more limited, and to residents on low incomes, wherever they live, who may struggle to afford additional transport costs. It will also impact on parents or carers of young children, especially those with two or more children, for whom travelling can be challenging.

We considered the availability of public transport in deciding on the location of the proposed central and delivery sites within the Early Help Offer. However, we expect to gain a more detailed understanding of this issue during the proposed consultation, and intend to carry out more detailed analysis of relevant data to inform the final decision in January 2017.

Mitigating actions may include scheduling activities at other local community venues, encouraging community-run activities, using mobile services, visiting people in their homes or other local venues, or providing minibus transport.
