#### 1. Summary

On 7<sup>th</sup> February 2018 the Licensing Department received an application for the grant of a Premises Licence for Sk 24 Hours 283 Old Wakefield Road. The application was made by Hanmant Singh Mashiana. A copy of this application may be seen at **APPENDIX A**.

#### 2. Information required to take a decision

This application is for a premises Licence, the premises will operate as a 24 hour off licence. The following hours and licensable activities have been applied for.:

The supply of Alcohol: Mon - Sunday: 00:00 - 00:00

**Hours of Opening**:  $Mon - Sun \quad 00:00 - 00:00$  (24 hours seven days per week)

The application has been advertised in accordance with the requirements of the Licensing Act 2003, the closing date for representations was **7/03/2018**. The Council has received 1 Representation from West Yorkshire Police and a further representation from a local business stating that they do not believe the following licensing objective will be achieved:

- The prevention of public nuisance.
- Prevention of Public Safety

In addition Environmental Health have put forward suitable conditions which they believe will ensure that the prevention of public nuisance objective will met. These may be seen at **Appendix D**.

Further to the original Police objection, the applicant has been in discussion with Richard Woodhead from West Yorkshire Police and an agreement has been reached to reduce the licenced hours and apply suitable voluntary conditions to address the original Police concerns. These conditions may be seen at **Appendix E**.






