- 1. The Premises Licence Holder will regularly risk assess the required provision of Door Security numbers and agree with. West Yorkshire Police.
- 2. There will be a maintained, comprehensive CCTV system which will be in working order. Images recorded will be saved for a 28 day minimum. A member of staff will be on site who is capable of working the CCTV and downloading images for the Police or Licensing Authority upon request.
- 3. Door staff working at the front door of the premises to wear high visibility clothing at all times.
- 4. The Premises Licence Holder will agree an action plan with West Yorkshire Police and this will be reviewed by West Yorkshire Police & Tokyo Industries on a regular basis.
- 5. Any incident of crime & disorder will be recorded in the incident book and will be reported to West Yorkshire Police.
- 6. If the premises are to trade after 02.00 on any night then the following conditions will be effective from 00.00 (midnight):
 - A metal detection arch and / or wands will be used at the premises and there will be a search policy in place on evening sessions.
 - All bottle drinks will be decanted into plastic glasses. Single serve bottle service is excluded for table packages, the consumption of these packages will be monitored by management and staff.
 - A body camera will be used on the front door.
 - Crowd barriers will be used on busy evening sessions.
 - When the outside area is trading a member of security will be in position in the outside area.
