Notice under Regulation 10: Key Decision where less than 28 days' public notice has been given

Pursuant to Regulation 10 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 ('the Regulations'), I hereby give Notice that:-

The **Cabinet** intends to make a Key Decision on behalf of Kirklees Council on 26 November 2020 regarding the Additional Restrictions Grant which forms part of the package of Government support for businesses in response to the national lockdown.

It has not been possible to give 28 clear days' notice of the intention to make the Key Decision. The reasons why compliance is impracticable in this matter are as follows:-

- details of the scheme were published by Government on 4th November 2020 and to minimise any delay in making the grants available to businesses it is considered appropriate for Cabinet to consider this item at the 26th November meeting.
