Notice under Regulation 10: Key Decision where less than 28 days' public notice has been given

Pursuant to Regulation 10 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 ('the Regulations'), I hereby give Notice that:-

The **Cabinet** intends to make a Key Decision on behalf of Kirklees Council on **15 December 2020** regarding local implementation of the Government COVID winter grant scheme to help families provide food for children over the holidays, and other support for families and individuals.

It has not been possible to give 28 clear days' notice of the intention to make the Key Decision. The reasons why compliance is impracticable in this matter are as follows:-
