Notice under Regulation 10: Key Decision where less than 28 days' public notice has been given

Pursuant to Regulation 10 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 ('the Regulations'), I hereby give Notice that:-

The Cabinet intends to make a Key Decision on behalf of Kirklees Council on 14th December 2021 regarding **The ongoing implementation of the compliance review and related improvement plan.**

It has not been possible to give 28 clear days' notice of the intention to make the Key Decision. The reasons why compliance is impracticable in this matter are as follows:-

The Key Decision was due to be presented to January Cabinet on the basis of an expected decision from the Regulator of Social Housing and the outcome of the Regulation Panel assessment of our self-referral in submitted in January 2021. The decision was received earlier and hence we would like to sight Cabinet at the earliest opportunity and not delay till January 2022
