
Question 5 - Do you agree that all vehicle proprietors who do NOT hold a valid hackney carriage / private hire drivers' badge should complete a basic disclosure from the DBS (Disclosure Barring Service) at first application and a check required annually for the duration of the vehicle licence?

Summary of DfT requirement and reason: -

Enhanced DBS and barred list checks are not available for vehicle licensing. Licensing authorities should require a basic disclosure from the DBS and that a check is undertaken annually. Any individual may apply for a basic check and the certificate will disclose any unspent convictions recorded on the Police National Computer (PNC). Licensing authorities should consider whether an applicant or licence holder with a conviction for offences, other than those relating to driving, meet the 'fit and proper' threshold.
