Community Reward Scheme

- "To give back to communities and enrich their economy, environment, and wellbeing"
- Funding for the development of a Community Chest small grants for practical items to support reuse and waste minimisation initiatives; and the use of incentivised reward schemes for improved recycling.

Reuse Shop

- Setting up a trial shop in Huddersfield
- If successful, developing a self-sustaining solution in Huddersfield and Dewsbury

Improved Litter Facilities

- Comprehensive auditing and database of all litter bins across the borough. Discussion will take place at ward level as a
 part of the litter bin review and replacement planning.
- Trialling innovative solutions for on-the-go recycling, such as clear, improved signage, big-belly bins, auto-sorting bins at venues

• Automated camera and AI technology to tackle environmental crime

Glass Collection Trial

- Trialling different types of bins and vehicles across all types of Kirklees communities
- Options summary to be compiled into recommendations for an authority wide roll out.

Bulky Collections – Third Sector Reuse Partner

 Trialling a partnership with a third sector organisation that can collect and distribute previously loved items to Kirklees communities most in need. Supporting this partnership through asset provision such as vehicles.

Depot Review (Site surveys, etc)

- Site in north is at maximum capacity, additional space in South is also required. Depot space needed to accommodate glass and other recycling and waste initiatives.
- Funds required at this stage for early feasibility studies, site surveys
