Notice under Regulation 10: Key Decision where less than 28 days' public notice has been given

Pursuant to Regulation 10 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 ('the Regulations'), I hereby give Notice that: -

The **Service Director for Regeneration and Skills** intends to make a Key Decision on behalf of Kirklees Council on **26th August 2022** regarding the acceptance of grant funding from DWP to deliver the Local Supported employment initiative. The funding will be used to support an additional 120 Kirklees residents with a learning disability into work via a supported employment model. It will be delivered in partnership between Employment and Skills service and REAL employment.

It has not been possible to give 28 clear days' notice of the intention to make the Key Decision. The reasons why compliance is impracticable in this matter are as follows: -

Confirmation of the successful application for grant funding was received on 16th August 2022 with instructions to return the signed grant agreement by 26th August 2022 to avoid jeopardising the funding
