If the shop was granted with a license to sell Alcohol from 6am-11pm the off-licence Would attract more anti social behaviour, noise nuisance early morning and late at night.

It will create more underage Drinking and drug dealing.

Also public nuisance to myself and Neighbours being fearful of going out after dark due to too many Teenagers drinking and hanging around on the grassed area across from the shop and the derelict school at the side of the shop.

they already use this area to sit and drink then start kicking footballs at cars etc.

More litter in our Gardens that is already a problem without the shop being open for longer.

This is already noticeable now after the shop using these hours for the past 4 or 5 weeks, this will only get worse as lighter days and the summer comes.

The lights from the shop are a general nuisance staying on full white boards until 11.30pm when they slam the roller shutters down.

There are already three co-op's, Wooldale, Woodlands and New Mill all within a lot less than half a mile from this location in each direction that serve alcohol, tobacco and Newspapers and general grocery products from 7.30am until 9pm.

If the shop is to be granted a licence then I do think that 7.30am to 7pm 7 days per week is more acceptable.
