- Summary updates for the other two priorities

The general update on the implementation of the KHWS may include, for example, reference to the development of the website, launch of the self assessment tool, how partners are implementing, monitoring and reporting on work associated with the strategy, engagement activity associated with the KHWS etc.

The in depth update on the one priority will include:

- A general overview of work under the priority and optional area(s) to highlight in detail
- Successes
- Challenges
- Requests for support

The two summary updates will be brief, it is suggested they are limited to one slide each. They may include:

- A general overview
- An area to highlight
- Successes
- Challenges
- Request for support

Updates on the priorities will be presented by leads working on the priorities (except in exceptional circumstances). Given the range of colleagues and partners involved and breadth of work under each priority those presenting the updates may vary by meeting.
