You may be aware, the Council is in receipt of a Definitive Map Modification Order ("DMMO") application for land between Wood Nook and Wilshaw to upgrade public footpaths Meltham 70 and Meltham 38 (part) to bridleway from point A to point B on the application plan, on the basis that the definitive map and statement should be modified. We are aware that this is not within the Holme Valley Parish Council area, but is adjacent.

The Council has received a direction on behalf of the Secretary of State, at DEFRA, to determine this application by 30 June 2018.

The Council has a duty to investigate this matter and is contacting user groups and others who may have an interest.

When considering whether the definitive map and statement of public rights of way requires modification, we consider evidence relating to the existence of public rights, not whether people want or do not want any alleged public rights to be recorded.
