Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981
Part III Public Rights of Way
Modified Definitive Map

In February, 1980 a Review of the Definitive Path Map for the whole of the West Yorkshire area for which a Definitive Map had previously been in force was carried out by this Authority in the form of a Draft Revision Map, under the provisions of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949, and the Countryside Act 1968.

Many objections, valid and otherwise, were received but prior to any being resolved the 1981 Wildlife and Countryside Act came into being which laid down different procedures in relation to Reviews of Definitive Maps. Consequently the Department of the Environment instructed that the Draft Revision Map be abandoned; that all contentious matters on the map be removed therefrom, and the Resultant Map be then published as a Modified Definitive Map. The contentious matters will be dealt with on an individual basis.

This Modified Definitive Map will be placed on public display throughout the County on the 25th October, 1985 for an unspecified period.

Following upon this exercise it is the intention to forward to each District two complete District Maps and Statements and perhaps you would care to indicate an appropriate department or Officers to whom such maps should be handed.
