Dear Mr. Eggins,

I enclose herewith a photostat copy of a letter sent to your Department in March 1973, when the British Horse Society joined forces with the Ramblers' Association to have various footpaths and bridleways reviewed at that time for the new Definitive Maps. We never heard anything official, but I was given to understand that all three paths mentioned on the 1973 letter had been upgraded to bridleways because of their width, condition, and long usage as such.

However, Manor Farm at Wilshaw has recently changed hands, and the new manager has wired off paths 38 and 70, leaving only access for walkers, and incidentally, been very abusive to a middle-aged lady who rode down there in all innocence, as she has done for many years, the otherday.

The latter, although unpleasant is somewhat irrelevant, but I would be most obliged if you will kindly clarify the situation as to whether these are bridleways or footpaths, and if the latter, what steps would be taken to upgrade them.

Your kind attention will be greatly appreciated, and your reply eagerly awaited by myself and all the other residents of this little area around Woodnook.
