Notice under Regulation 10: Key Decision where less than 28 days' public notice has been given

Pursuant to Regulation 10 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 ('the Regulations'), I hereby give Notice that:-

The **Cabinet** intends to make a Key Decision on behalf of Kirklees Council on **10/09/24** regarding the future of library provision following consideration of findings from recent informal consultation and other relevant details relating to the library service.

It has not been possible to give 28 clear days' notice of the intention to make the Key Decision. The reasons why compliance is impracticable in this matter are as follows:-

The timelines for briefing and availability of relevant officers and members during the summer period has impacted on the ability to ensure publication within the required working hours on the 12/08/24.
