


Mellor and Molly Carr Woods Woodland Extension Proposals

Woodland
 A native woodland mix of oak, rowan, silver birch, hazel and hawthorn will be used, mirroring species found in the existing woodlands. The planted areas will have spaces and rides between them to allow for views and vistas and for maintenance to be carried out. In wetter areas alder and willow will be planted as they grow well in these conditions.

Open lower growing woodland
 Species such as blackthorn, hawthorn, hazel, gorse and broom will be planted in denser groups that are widely spaced to create a naturalistic mosaic habitat. This type of habitat is great for birds.

Natural regeneration
 Areas near to existing woodlands and trees are left for trees to grow naturally from seeds spreading from these areas. Progress will be monitored, and additional planting can be added later, if required.
