

## **Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012**

### **Notice under Regulation 10: Key Decision where less than 28 days' public notice has been given**

Pursuant to Regulation 10 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 ('the Regulations'), I hereby give Notice that: -

The **Cabinet** intends to make a Key Decision on behalf of Kirklees Council on 6 May 2025 regarding [**The Combined Authorities (Adult Education Functions) (Amendment) Order 2025**]

It has not been possible to give 28 clear days' notice of the intention to make the Key Decision. The reasons why compliance is impracticable in this matter are as follows: -

Local authority consent to the making of the Order by the Government is required as quickly as possible to enable the Order to be enacted prior to the start of the 2025/26 academic year. Any delay would impact on the availability of and funding for the new technical qualifications that are the subject of the proposed Order.
