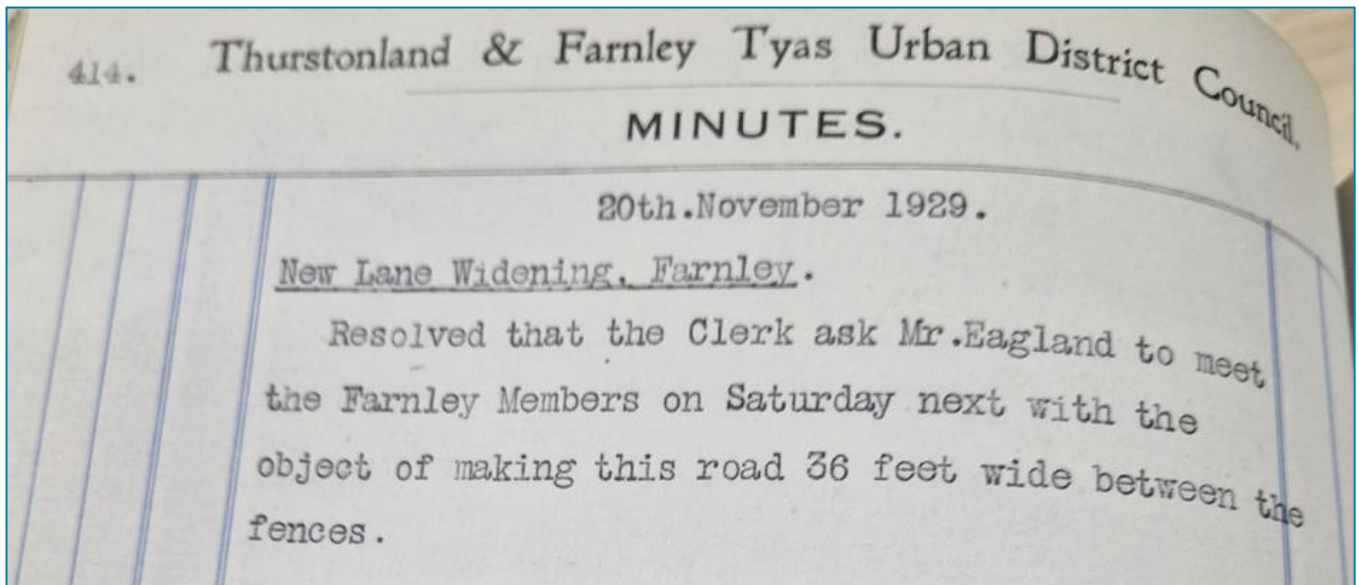

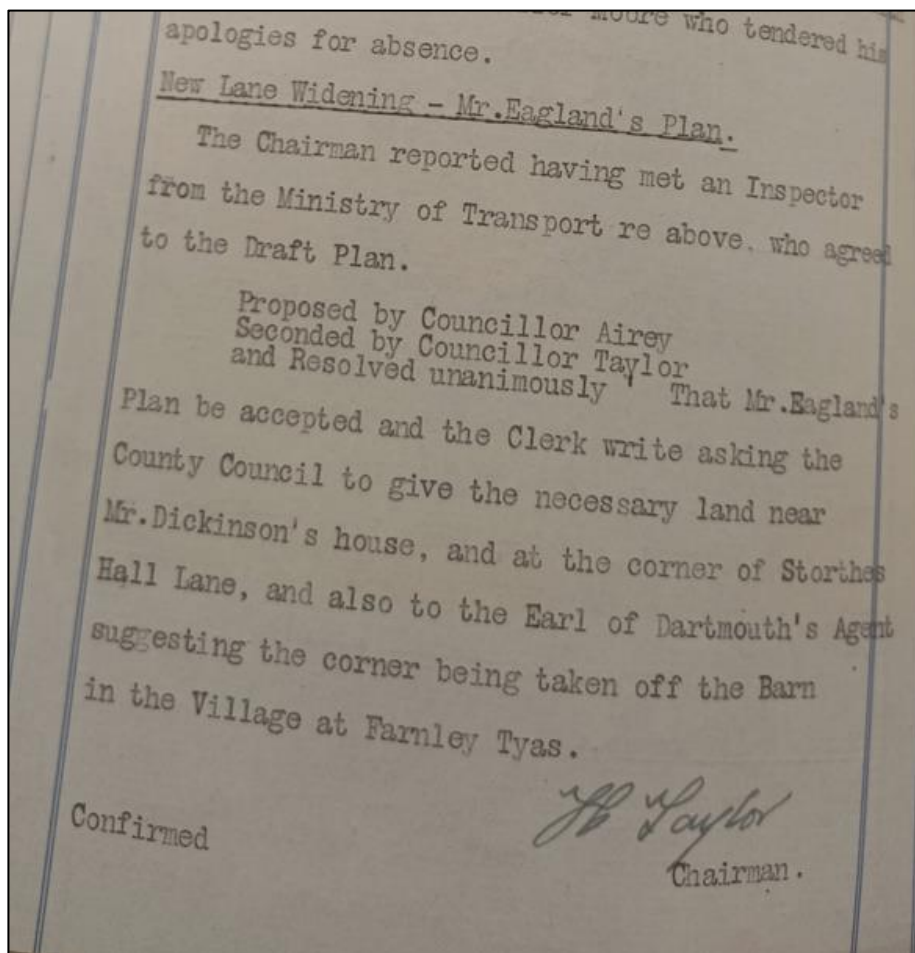

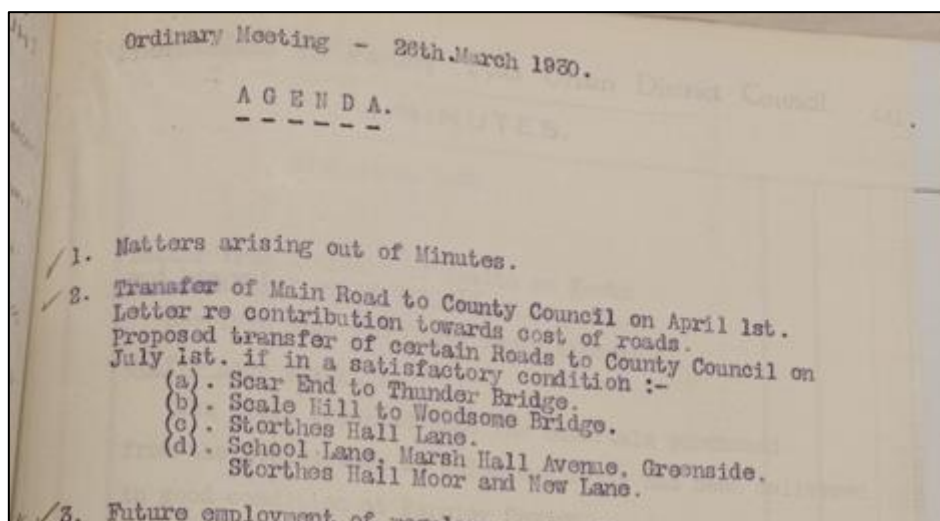
New Lane Widening (between Storthes Hall Lane and The Village) – Dated 20th November 1929
