Ludhill Lane

Mr Mallinson mentioned that a deputation of Farmers had waited upon Mr Wilson, Lord Dartmouth's lab steward relative to the state of Ludhill Lane, that Mr Wilson indicated that they

would have no objection to put it into a proper state of repair provided that the Board would afterwards take it over & maintain it. It was formally decided that the Board should meet on the spot on Saturday 17th [**] next at 2pm & look over the Road.

A letter from Mr Wilson was read herein, stating that the question of repairing Ludhill Lane was not as represented at last meeting – as Lord Dartmouths lab agent he stated that if the Board were desirous of taking over the road to repair he would represent the matter to Mr Heymund, & see if he was willing to put in to a thorough state of repair with that object in view. Under these circumstances nothing further was done in the matter.
