- 1.1 The CQC is the independent regulator of health and adult social care and its role is to monitor, inspect and regulate services to make sure that they meet fundamental standards of quality and safety.
- 1.2 In April 2017 CQC presented to the Panel an outline of its activity and an overview of the outcomes of the inspections in Kirklees. CQC also informed the Panel of the CQC model of regulation which included the role of CQC in providing an independent voice on the state of health and adult social care in England
- 1.3 The outcomes of the meeting included an agreement for the Panel to continue to focus on the work and activity of CQC and to arrange a further update from CQC with a focus on adult social care.
